Properties of Solutions 2 ¼ miscible—When two or more liquids mix (ex. Water and food coloring) ¾ immiscible—When two or more liquids DON'T mix.—they usually layer if allowed to set for a while. (ex. Water and oil) Concentration Units ¼ Molarity (M) = # of moles of solute per liter of solution; IS temperature dependent.

### 2006 AP CHEMISTRY FREE-RESPONSE QUESTIONS

Free Response Qestion (1991) 2) The molecular formula of a hydrocarbon is to be determined by analyzing its combustion products and investigating its colligative properties. (a) The hydrocarbon burns completely, producing 7.2 grams of water and 7.2 liters of CO2 at standard conditions.
