While many online sources do not have a page number, academic journals almost always do, even when they are available online. In most cases, the in-text citation is at the end of the sentence in parentheses. If you use the author's name in the text, you don't have to repeat it in the parenthesis at the end.

APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

A reference list, or cite list, at the end of the work is later included to provide a more detailed listing of the sources used. Text citations contain, in parenthesis, the author's last name and the publication year of the work that is being cited, with the name and year being separated by a comma.

How to Cite Cite your sources both in-text and at the end of your paper. For in-text citation, the easiest method is to parenthetically give the author's last name and the year of publication, e.g., (Clarke 2001), but the exact way you cite will depend on the specific type of style guide you follow.
