The Manual was commissioned by the essayist and playwright Li Yü, whose house and bookshop was called the Mustard Seed Garden, whence the Manual's name. The texts were compiled and images prepared between 1679 and 1701 by the three brothers Wang Kai, Wang Shih and Wang Nieh. It has long been considered a classic.
